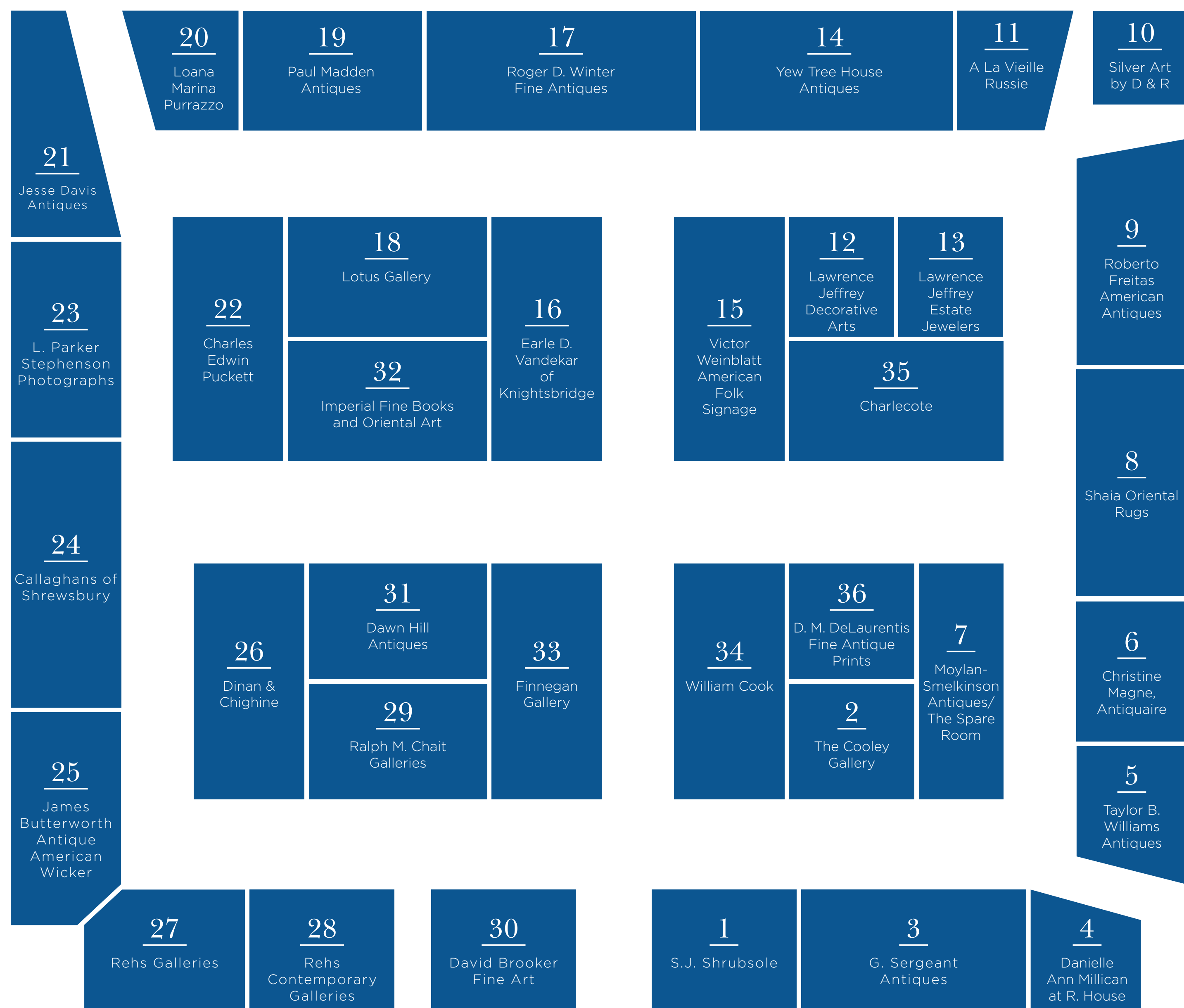

- Provide a written invoice that includes age, origin, construction, and disclosure of condition
- Guarantee every item to be as described.
- Make a full refund if the description proves to misrepresent the item (provided that the antique is returned in the same condition in which it was sold).
